COVID-19 POLICY



At the Carrington Ballet Academy we take Covid-19 seriously and will do everything possible to ensure the safety of students and parents/guardians.

- 1. Carrington Ballet Academy follows Scottish Government Guidelines on Covid-19 and offers guidance on how these can be adhered to. These guidelines change regularly.
- 2. Parents / Guardians and students are politely asked to adhere to all Covid-19 Scottish Government Guidelines and are personally responsible for doing so.
- 3. Carrington Ballet Academy is only responsible for parents / guardians and students that are enrolled into the Carrington Ballet Academy, we are not responsible for any other parties using the venue or the studio.
- 4. The studio barre's will be cleaned before and after every class, hand sanitiser will be provided.
- 5. Guidance will be provided to students so they can be aware of their surroundings and adhere to the social distancing guidelines by the Scottish Government on the barre, in the center and entering & exiting the building or using the venue's facilities eg. toilets.
- 6. We politely ask that Students' belongings be marked with their name clearly to avoid unnecessary contact, this includes the use of water bottles. Water Bottles should not be shared under any circumstance even if another student does not have their own water bottle, this applies to family members also.
- 7. Students who display flu-like symptoms will be sent home, however we seek the parent / guardian's cooperation to avoid sending your child to class if they display such symptoms. Likewise if anyone in your household displays such symptoms we politely ask that you avoid sending your child to class. The only exception for this is if they have done any Covid-19 test and the result is negative. In the instance that your child misses a class due to illness or Covid-19 then you may request a catch up class, this catch up class can not always be guaranteed.
- 8. To drop off your child to class please do not arrive any more than 10 minutes prior to the class, to collect your child please do not arrive any more than 10 minutes before class has finished. Unless sufficient space is available in the waiting area where we politely ask that you follow Social Distancing Guidelines set out by the Scottish Government.
- Face coverings are voluntary for those taking classes/exercise at the Carrington Ballet Academy, although advised to help protect everyone from Covid-19 transmission. Face coverings are voluntary for entering and exiting the venue/building although advised.

10. Physical contact should be avoided if possible between everyone who is inside the venue. With the exception of the Principal / Teacher during the class in the circumstance of corrections or to control a situation.
